KEY COMPONENTS

Service Learning Volunteer for organizations within the Southwest, Native American cultures, and sustainable ecology

Global Community Building & Cultural Experience Develop new perspectives that challenge initial understandings

Project Development Arrive with an existing problem from their community. Leave with a plan of action that improves or solves it

Leadership Development Engage in collaborative activities that define and develop leadership qualities

Wilderness Challenge Experience challenging hiking and overnight camping that will push their limits
